Tosti Prosecco DOC NV– Veneto, Italy

£24.95 £7

Aromas of elderflower and exotic fruits perpetuate, the delicate perlage underlining the kick of fruitiness perfectly. Refined and elegant.

Ruggeri Giall'Oro, Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore DOCG NV– Veneto, Italy

£34.95

Very delicate with hints of golden apples and acacia flowers. The off-dry palate is fresh and light with an extremely smooth and well-balanced, fruity finish.

Baron De Marck Brut NV – Champagne, France

£49.95

A pure, soft Champagne with a stylish character. An uplifting note of freshly baked brioche adds complexity and class to an elegantly balanced palate.

Laurent-Perrier Cuvee Rose Brut NV – Champagne, France

£85

Intensely fruity flavours, it has a long length and is rounded and supple on the finish.

West Coast Swing White Zinfandel – California, USA 2018

£18 £4.75 £6.25

Full of ripe fruit aromas such as peaches, mango and melon. Juicy on the palate with strawberry and tropical fruit flavours with fresh acidity balancing the sweetness. Bright white gold in colour with a pronounced, vibrant nose showing citrus and floral aromas with a hint of brioche. The palate is full of minerality and the finish is fine and elegant.

La Vidaubanaise Comte de Provence Rosé – Provence, France 2018

A classic Provence rosé packed full of strawberry and peach, and laced with a zingy citrus acidity. Incredibly quaffable, it's ideal on a hot summer's day.

Sospiro Bianco - Emilia Romagna, Italy NV

Harmonic on the palate, with refreshing acidity. Intense white fruit flavours prevail, with delicate, subtle overtones of floral notes and a hint of gooseberry coming through on the finish.

Casa de Rossa Pinot Grigio – Veneto, Italy 2018

£18 £4.75 £6.25

Lemony on the nose, with a delicious balance in the mouth, this Pinot Grigio is a very easy to drink dry white, with a sublime lingering finish reminiscent of fresh garden herbs and peach.

Vamonos Sauvignon Blanc – Chile 2018

£19 £5 £6.75

Pale yellow colour with green hues, intense aromas of pineapple and mango with soft herbal notes. A delightfully fresh Sauvignon Blanc, which balances acidity with a fruity finish.

Markview Chardonnay – South Eastern Australia NV

Pale straw yellow, with a welcoming palate of fresh fruit and oak. Pleasant, creamy texture with a little sweetness and a soft finish.

Trapiche Melodias Torrontes – Mendoza, Argentina 2019

£23.50 £6.50 £8.25

Vibrant, aromatic and refreshing, with a melody of floral and tropical fruit flavours that leads to a wonderfully light, sweet freshness on the close.

Picpoul de Pinet Les Prades, Caves de l'Ormarine – Languedoc, France 2018

£25 £7.25 £8.50

Clear, brilliant yellow with green tints. Fine fresh, fruity and floral aromas. Good aromatic persistence with overtones of citrus fruit. Lively, fresh with lemony and floral touches followed by a light refreshing grapefruit finish.

Weingut Tesch Riesling Queen of Whites – Nahe, Germany 2017

Rich, with notes of acacia, honey and lime on the nose. On the palate it possess amazing concentration of fruit balanced by fine minerality and crisp acidity.

Yealands Estate Single Block L5 Sauvignon Blanc – Marlborough, New Zealand 2018

£38

The L5 block is known for its intense mineral and herbal character. Pure, lifted flavours of wild thyme and citrus characterise the nose. The palate is rich and textured, with firm mineral flavours that give exceptional length.

Château Favray Pouilly-Fumé – Loire, France 2018

£40

Floral and fruity bouquet with crisp, citrus fruit, great length and piercing tones of limestone minerality. Round, lush and utterly elegant.

Ken Forrester FMC Chenin Blanc – Western Cape, South Africa 2018

£55

The pinnacle of what we consider to be the finest expression of the grapes of this varietal an icon chenin, a challenge to the world! Rich, layered with dried apricot, vanilla and honey.

Domaine Louis Michel Chablis 1er Cru Montmains – Burgundy, France 2018

£65

Bright white gold in colour with a pronounced, vibrant nose showing citrus and floral aromas with a hint of brioche. The palate is full of minerality and the finish is fine and elegant.

Vinamar Merlot – Casablanca Valley, Chile 2018

Deep and bright ruby red. Intense plum aromas on the nose, with cinnamon and black pepper notes. On the palate, the wine is flavoursome and medium-bodied, with a long, satisfying finish.

Trapiche Melodias Winemaker Selection Malbec – Mendoza, Argentina 2018

A juicy, medium bodied wine with notes of ripe plums, black cherries and a touch of sweet spice.

D'Arenberg d'Arry's Original Shiraz/Grenache – Australia 2016

The structure and dark, earthy flavour of Shiraz, paired with the fragrance and pure fruit of Grenache are the hallmarks of a great d'Arry's Original.

Lucien Lurton et Fils Reserve de Lucien Lurton Red – Bordeaux – France 2017

£25

Deep purple in colour with an expressive nose. Medium-bodied, rounded tannins, packed with red fruits and a touch of spice on the palate. A complex wine with a long finish.

Château Ste. Michelle Columbia Valley Syrah – Washington, USA 2016

£37

An approachable and fruit-forward Syrah with an inviting velvety texture, brimming with flavours of red fruit and crushed dark berries. Deep, Intense and Spicy.

Château Villegeorge Etoile de Villegeorge – Bordeaux, France 2016

£37

Dark, deep red colour. Nose is expressive of berries and flowers (strawberry, raspberry, peony). On the palate the wine is soft well-rounded with a beautiful harmony between power and velvety ripe tannins.

Da Vinci Chianti Classico – Tuscanay, Italy 2018

£38

Full-bodied with juicy fruit notes, this wine displays vibrant aromas of fresh plum, blackberry and spice. Cherry and violet flavours on the palate interlace with a hint of spicy cinnamon.

Trapiche Perfiles Malbec Textura Fina - Mendoza, Argentina 2018

£45

This Malbec is smooth, fruity and delicious with medium tannins and a fantastic structure. High altitudes and well-drained soil give a wine with unparalleled levels of concentration and finesse.

Ramon Bilbao Rioja Gran Reserva – Rioja, Spain 2011

£48

A complex, concentrated red, with plenty of backbone and structure. Fresh acidity combines with layers of ripe plum, savoury cedar notes, and spicy vanilla oak, with just a touch of cherry.

Bertani Amarone Valpantena DOCG – Veneto, Italy 2016

£55

Deep scents of sour cherry, berries and a mix of spices come through on the nose. In the mouth, soft and rounded flavours of red fruit prevail.

Domaine Lucien Boilot Gevrey-Chambertin – Burgundy, France 2017

£65

Exceptionally complex with aromas of black cherry and liquorice, balanced with an enticing smoky character. The palate is characterised by balanced acidity, integrated oak and modest tannins.
